Permits must be obtained from Deep River Town Office during their regular business hours. Construction and demolition waste is defined as all non-hazardous low metal content waste from construction and demolition clean up projects, consisting primarily of; wood, blocks/stone/bricks, non-metal roofing material, insulation, waste furniture (does not include mattresses and box springs), window glass, non metal siding material, concrete and small amounts of plastic and fiberglass.
