



Important Notice for Laurentian Hills Residents Regarding **GARBAGE**

Beginning May 1, 2017, the **Town of Laurentian Hills** will introduce a **two (2) bag limit** for residential household waste collection. Businesses are exempt from these bag limits. The purpose of this bag limit is to encourage all residents to recycle. Increased diversion of waste will increase the life of local landfills and reduce waste management costs for residents.

Definition of Two (2) Bags

Two bags are defined as two individual garbage bags, two waste containers or a combination of both that hold a maximum combined volume of 154 litres of household waste. (A standard garbage bag measuring 26"x32" equals 77 litres.)

What if I have more than "two bags"?

You can purchase bag tags and attach them to all bags in excess of the two (2) bag limit. Bag tags can be purchased Monday through Friday during regular business hours at the Point Alexander Municipal Office for \$2.00 each.

Can I take extra bags to the Baggs Road Landfill Site?

Yes. However, all residents of Laurentian Hills and Deep River will be required to pay \$2.00 per bag or the bag must have a bag tag attached to it to dispose of waste at the Baggs Road Landfill Site.

What should I do if I have questions?

For the first four (4) months up until August 31, 2017, staff will work closely with the collection contractor to facilitate a smooth transition to ensure compliance with the bag limits. If you have any questions, please contact the Municipal Office at **Laurentian Hills: (613) 584-3114**.
