

TOWN OF LAURENTIAN HILLS

BY-LAW NO. 32 /00

Being a by-law to regulate the time, manner and nature of the use
of the supply of water in the Town of Laurentian Hills

WHEREAS under Section 12 of the Public Utilities Act, RSO 1990, Chapter P 52, municipalities may pass by-laws for regulating the time, manner, extent and nature of use of the water supplied by the Town water works system;

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Laurentian Hills deems it necessary and desirable to control the consumption of an use of water during specific times of the year;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Laurentian Hills enacts as follows:

1. This by-law applies to all persons being an owner, tenant, occupant, servant or employee of any house, dwelling unit, building, or any such other place or structure having its potable water supplied by the Town of Laurentian Hills water works system.
2. From May 1 to October 1 in each and every year, no person shall use water from the said water works system, to water or sprinkle by hose, pipe or any other connection, lawns, gardens, grass, plots, boulevards, grounds of any description, except at periods between 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 am and 7:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. on any day.
3. (a) At anytime during the calendar year, when in the opinion of the Public Works Superintendent or his/her designate, the abundant flow of water is threatened by weather, mechanical or any other cause or reason, all permission is withdrawn and watering by hose, pipe or any other connection of lawns, gardens, grass, plots, boulevards or grounds of any description shall cease for the specified period.

(b) At anytime during the calendar year, when in the opinion of the Public Works Superintendent or his/her designate may declare other measures deemed necessary in order to ensure abundant flow of water for drinking, cooking, personal hygienic, medical and other essential uses.
4. Upon declaring such restrictions of this by-law, the Provincial Offences Officer shall cause to be published on at least one occasion in the local newspaper or by household flyer, a notice of such restriction measures taken.
5. Penalty

The Provincial Offences Officer shall issue only one warning to the person who contravenes this by-law, per season.

Every person who subsequently contravenes any provision of this by-law after the one warning and on conviction is liable to a fine of \$10.00 for the first offence and \$25.00 for a second offence and subsequent offences during the same season, and such fine is recoverable under the Provincial Offences Act, RSO 1990.

6. Repeal

That By-Law No. 98-22 formerly the Village of Chalk River is hereby rescinded in its entirety and all previous by-laws for the regulating of the time, manner, extent and nature of the use of water.

READ a FIRST and SECOND time the 14th day of June, 2000.

READ a THIRD time and finally passed the 14th day of June, 2000.
