3. <u>DELEGATIONS/PRESENTATIONS</u>

(a) Mr. James Leon the Waste Site Coordinator for the North Renfrew Landfill Operations Board spoke to Council regarding the Bagg's Road Landfill.

Mr. Leon reported that the landfill is running smoothly and due to ongoing activities to reduce recycling materials the landfill now an estimated 21 years of life left.

Mr. Leon was asked about looking for a new site. The process is long and lengthy and the MOE may not grant another site if you are not doing all you can do divert materials that do not belong in a landfill. The option to apply to extend the current site is a possibility however education and additional promoting of recycling needs to continue and improve in order to extend the life of the current site.

(a) The Public Works Superintendent's Report for March 2014 and proposed work schedule for the month of April 2014 were received and reviewed.
