Message from Mayor, John (Jed) Reinwald THANK YOU!!!!

Our community has been living with the effects of COVID-19 since the Province declared a state of emergency under the *Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act* on March 17th, 2020.

We have been through a complete Provincial shut down with only essential services operating. We've seen indoor and outdoor spaces closed and people advised to stay home to help flatten the curve. Schools and day care services were closed, work places shut down, it's felt like we were shut ins, but those efforts have brought us to where we are now working towards recovery, to reopen our Province.

We have been very fortunate that there has been a low number of cases of the virus in Renfrew County. I believe that this is due to our communities being diligent with practicing social distancing, washing our hands, staying home as much as possible and using the curb side pick up services offered by the local businesses that were open. These measures were effective in keeping our families, friends, and our most vulnerable residents safe. Please accept my sincere THANK YOU for all the efforts that you and your families have put into looking out for our community.

As a result of the progress that we have made with the virus, as of Friday July 17th we entered Phase 3, which means that nearly all businesses and public spaces are allowed to re-open, as long as we follow the public health advice and workplace safety guidance necessary to keep everyone safe.

On July 14th the Renfrew County Medical Officer of Health put a mandatory measure in place that requires all residents to wear a mask/face covering when entering any public indoor space. This is to protect yourself and those around you. You do not need to wear a mask outdoors just maintain your physical distance.

We've made great progress to date, let's not become complacent, please continue to follow the guidance of our Provincial and local experts in Public Health. We are in this together and together we are stronger.

The Town office is open to the public during regular business hours, Monday to Friday 8:30 to 4:30 and COVID-19 protocols are in place. However, some departments are only available by appointment. Please call the office at 613-584-3114 or visit our web site at www.laurentianhills.ca.

Planning on Building? When is a Permit Required?

Any new building over 108 ft 2 (9 x 12) including garages, decks, and porches. If a building is less than 108 ft 2 (9 x 12) it must still meet the zoning and all setback requirements for the property. Any addition to an existing building including porches or decks. Any extensive renovations that would include structural alterations. Demolition of any building. All sewage systems. Partitioning and finishing a basement. Damp proofing or waterproofing foundation walls, including installation of drainage tile.

Communication Towers

Considering installing or having installed a free-standing Tower on your property?

- A building permit is required for the construction of a tower.
- Complete plans and specifications, engineered drawings and a site plan are required to be included in the permit application.
- The zoning setbacks from property lines apply to tower location on the lot.
- An inspection by your local building official of the footing excavation and forming, before concrete is poured, is required to ensure compliance with the engineered drawings.

Please note that no work is to commence until the building permit is issued. There may be liability concerns as to who is responsible if a tower should collapse and cause damage or injury, check with your insurance provider. Contact your municipal building department if you have any questions to ensure the construction process is followed.

Renfrew County Virtual Triage and Assessment Centre

The Renfrew County Virtual Triage and Assessment Centre (RC VTAC) was created in response to the COVID-19 pandemic to strengthen access to primary care for all Renfrew County residents. It connects Renfrew County residents who have a health concern (including COVID-19 concerns) but either do not have a family physician or cannot access their usual family physician with 24/7 care and support from a family physician, nurse practitioner and/or community paramedic via phone, video or an in-home assessment. It also provides referrals to other services including mental health support. The RC VTAC is a collaboration between Renfrew County Family Health Teams, Community Health Centres, the County of Renfrew Paramedic Service, Renfrew County Hospitals and the Renfrew County and District Health Unit, with the support of Ontario Health East.

Eligible Renfrew County residents can contact the RC VTAC at 1-844-727-6404. This new service is covered by OHIP with a valid health card. Learn more at www.rcvtac.ca Please have your OHIP number ready when you call.
