Merry Christmas from the Mayor, Council and Staff

The Municipal office will be closed on December 24 until January 1, 2021. The office will be closed for Family Day on February 15, 2021. Regular office hours are: Monday–Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The office is closed on statutory holidays.

CHRISTMAS and NEW YEAR'S Garbage Changes

No Garbage pick-up on Friday December 25, 2020. *Pick up will be* Thursday December 24, 2020. No pick-up on January 1, 2021. *Pick up will be* Thursday December 31, 2020. Regular Tuesday garbage pickup will NOT change.

Outdoor Rinks

The Town is planning to allow its three outdoors rinks to be open for the 2020/2021 season. The opening of the rinks is contingent on the availability of volunteers to establish and maintain the rinks.

Please note that following will be in effect:

- > All the rink buildings will be CLOSED to the public.
- > In accordance with the Provincial guidelines for outdoor gatherings, a limited number of people will be allowed on the ice at each location, follow all posted signage.
- > You must maintain a physical distancing of 2 metres (6ft) from anyone outside of your household at all times.
- > Mask and face coverings will be required.
- > Stay home if you are sick or experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19.
- > Sites may be periodically monitored to ensure Provincial guidelines are being adhered to.

Failure to adhere to the guidelines and posted signage may result in the closure of outdoor rinks.

Christmas Tree Safety Tips

When purchasing an artificial tree, look for the label "Fire Resistant." Although this label does not mean the tree won't catch fire, it does indicate the tree will resist burning and should extinguish quickly. When purchasing a live tree, check for freshness. A fresh tree is green; needles are hard to pull from branches and when bent between your fingers, needles do not break. The trunk butt of a fresh tree is sticky with resin, and when tapped on the ground, the tree should not lose many needles. When setting up a tree at home, place it away from fireplaces and radiators. Because heated rooms dry live trees out rapidly, be sure to keep the stand filled with water. Place the tree out of the way of foot traffic and do not block doorways.

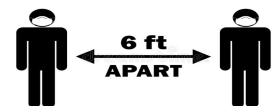

Taxes and Water and Sewer Payments

Cheques for taxes and water payments may be left in the night deposit box in Chalk River at 19 Railway or in Point Alexander 34465 Highway 17 at the main office. Planning on Building? When is a Permit Required?

Any new building over 108 ft² (9 x 12) including garages, decks, and porches. If a building is less than 108 ft² (9 x 12) it must still meet the zoning and all setback requirements for the property. Any addition to an existing building including porches or decks. Any extensive renovations that would include structural alterations. Demolition of any building. All sewage systems. Partitioning and finishing a basement. Damp proofing or waterproofing foundation walls, including installation of drainage tile.

Baggs Road Landfill

Winter Hours: Tuesday to Saturday 9 to 4 p.m. (November 3, 2020 to March 13, 2021). Fees can be paid by cash at the Baggs Road site or at the Town office.

Miller Road Landfill Construction/Demolition Waste

Hours: Tuesday to Saturday 9 a.m. to noon. Permits/Fees can be paid by cash at the Miller Road site or at the Deep River Town office.

Parking Restrictions

Please take note that effective December 1, 2020 winter parking restrictions are in effect. These restrictions prohibit parking a vehicle on any street, highway or Municipal road in such a manner as to interfere with Town services such as snow plowing. Vehicles in violation may be ticketed or towed.

HOLIDAY Water Samples Drop off

The final drop-off during the holidays before Christmas: December 22. Private citizen drinking water samples will not be accepted on the following days: December 23, 2020 through to January 4, 2021.
