Committee and Council Change Please take note that the July 1st Committee will be moved to July 8 (due to our Canada Day office closure)

No owner or person in charge of any animal shall allow the animal to defecate anywhere on property unless the owner ensures that the excreta are removed and disposed of in a sanitary manner. By-law No. 14-05 failure to comply is subject to a penalty. A reminder to NOT let your dogs or cats on beaches or playgrounds and be sure to NOT let them roam freely. Be sure your pet is on a leash at all times. If you ride a horse, pick up after it.

## EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS INFORMATION REGARDING SIRENS

Siren testing will be conducted on the first Sunday of each month at 12 noon for the duration of one minute. The siren testing tone will mimic the Westminster Chimes sound. During a real emergency at Chalk River Laboratories, sirens will sound to initiate either sheltering, evacuation to the Reception Area at the Deep River Arena, or to sound the All Clear. See below.

Protective Measure	Tone	Definition	Duration
Sheltering	Continuous rising and falling sound	Stay indoors, close all doors and windows. Listen to local radio Star 96.0 or CBC FM 92.5	30 min
Evacuation	Continuous Sound	Leave a potentially dangerous area and follow traffic directions to Deep River	30 min
All Clear	Intermittent	Termination of the emergency	2 min
