The watering hours are between 6:00 am and 8:00 am. and between 6:00 pm and 9:00 pm. It is illegal to connect your sump pump to the sewer system. (By-Law 19-10)

<u>Planning on Building? When is a</u> <u>Permit Required?</u>

Any new building over 108 ft 2 (9 x 12) including garages, decks, and porches. If a building is less than 108 ft 2 (9 x 12) it must still meet the zoning and all setback requirements for the property. Any addition to an existing building including porches or decks. Any extensive renovations that would include structural alterations. Demolition of any building. All sewage systems. Partitioning and finishing a basement. Damp proofing or waterproofing foundation walls, including installation of drainage tile.

Water Samples Drop off

Water Sample Bottles are available at the municipal office in Point Alexander. Samples to be taken the <u>same day</u> as they are dropped off. *April to August*->Drop off Monday to Thursdays. *September to March* -> Drop off Tuesday and Wednesday only.

Animal waste attracts rats, transmits disease and contains bacteria that can contaminate water which contribute to swim advisories and increased health risks for people using the beach.

<u>A Word from the</u> <u>Fire Chief and Fire-</u> <u>fighters</u>

It is mandatory for all residences with solid fuel burning appliances OR an attached garage to have working CO alarms as well as working smoke alarms on every level of their dwellings. If you do not have one of these devices present or in working order they will be issuing a \$235 fine for each faulty /or missing device.

Textile Recycling Bin and Re-Use Area

The Baggs Road Landfill Site Liaison Committee (SLC) and Operations Board is pleased to announce that the Site's Re-Use Area now has a textile recycling bin and acceptable materials for recycling are: Accessories: Hats, mittens, scarves, ties, socks, purses, wallets, backpacks and bags; Clothing and shoes: Men's, women's, children's clothing, shoes, boots, sandals and slippers; Bed and Bath Items: Bed/bath towels, sheets, blankets, pillows, curtains and tablecloths.
