A Word from the Fire Chief

As of April 15, 2015 it is mandatory for all residences with solid fuel burning appliances **OR** an attached garage to have working CO alarms as well as working smoke alarms on every level of their dwellings. After June 15, 2015, any time the Fire Department finds that you do not have one of these devices present or in working order they will be issuing a \$235 fine for each faulty /or missing device. The Fire Department is available to inspect your alarms or answer questions you may have about your requirement to have these devices. Call 613-584-3114 for more information.

Watering Restrictions

for users of the Chalk River water system. Even numbered houses may **only** water on even numbered days and odd numbered houses may **only** water on odd numbered days. Watering hours are between 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. and between 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. ***It's illegal to connect your sump pump to the sewer system.*** (By-Law 19-10)

Message from the O.P.P. False 911 Calls

Call 911 for life or death emergency requiring the immediate response of police, fire or ambulance. Do not call for non-emergencies such as the weather or road conditions.

A pocket-dial occurs when a cellular phone stored in an insecure fashion in places like pockets, handbags and backpacks inadvertently place calls while being tossed about. If you accidentally dial 9-1-1 stay on the line and tell the Provincial communication Centre what happened. It is OPP policy to dispatch an officer to every identifiable location of every 9-1-1- call to ensure the safety of the person who has made the call. **Do not** put 9-1-1 part of your programmed auto-dialling.

As of April 15, the OPP will be equipped to receive emergency calls for service via Text with 9-1-1 (T9-1-1) from persons who are deaf, hard of hearing or speech impaired.

WATER SAMPLE DROP OFF

Water Sample Bottles are available at the municipal office in Point Alexander. Samples to be taken the **same day** as they are dropped off.

April to August—> Monday to Thursday and from September to March —> Drop off Tuesday and Wednesday **only**.

No owner or person in charge of any animal shall allow the animal to defecate anywhere on property unless the owner ensures that the excreta are removed and disposed of in a sanitary manner. By-law No. 14-05 failure to comply is subject to a penalty. A reminder to **NOT** let your dogs or cats on beaches or playgrounds and be sure to **NOT** let them roam freely. Be sure your pet is on a leash **at all times**.
