## **THE STAY-AT-HOME ORDER IS NOW IN EFFECT ACROSS ONTARIO**

Effective January 14, 2021 at 12:01 a.m. the Provincial government **issued** a **stay-at-home order** requiring everyone to **remain at home** with exceptions for permitted purposes or activities, such as going to the grocery store or pharmacy, accessing health care services, for exercise or for work where the work cannot be done remotely.
