Garbage pickup on Friday 18 April will be rescheduled to Thursday 17 April, 2014. Regular Tuesday Garbage pickup will not be changed.



No owner or person in charge of any animal shall allow the animal to defecate anywhere on property unless the owner ensures that the excreta are removed and disposed of in a sanitary manner. By-law No. 14-05 failure to comply is subject to a penalty. A reminder to NOT let your dogs or cats on beaches or playgrounds and be sure to NOT let them roam freely. Be sure your pet is on a leash at all times. If you ride a horse, pick up after it.

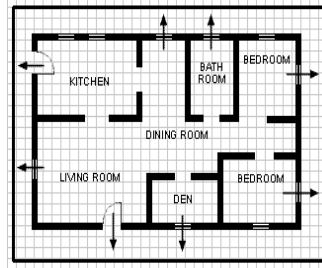

it is an emergency and not a controlled burn before calling 9-1-1.

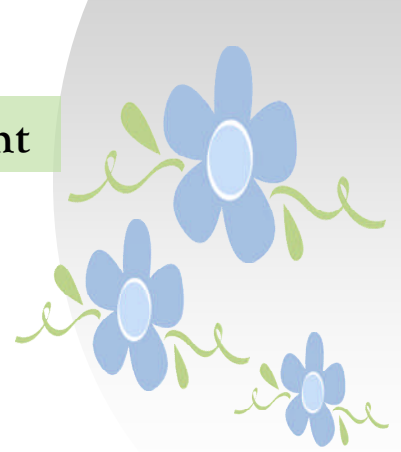
