Carefor Income Tax Returns Assistance

Carefor Will Help With Tax Returns. This program is for applicants with limited income, defined as \$30,000 for an individual and \$40,000 for a couple, \$35,000 for an adult with 1 child with an additional \$2,500 allowed for each additional child. Water Testing

Water testing bottles are available for residents with wells. Come to our office to pick up a bottle at 34465 Highway 17.

April to August drop off is Monday to Thursday.

September to March drop off is Tuesday and Wednesday only.

Watering Restrictions

Even numbered houses may only water on even numbered days and odd numbered houses may only water on odd numbered days and the watering hours are between 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. and between 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. It is illegal to connect your sump pump to the sewer system.

A Word from the Fire Chief

Make sure YOUR household is safe from carbon monoxide poisoning. Homeowners and landlords are responsible for ensuring their properties have working carbon monoxide (CO) alarms. This includes:

Testing:

It is recommended that carbon monoxide alarms be tested monthly or in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.

Batteries:

Replace batteries in carbon monoxide alarms once a year or whenever the low-battery warning sounds. Know the difference between a low-battery warning and an emergency alarm - consult the CO alarm manufacturer's instructions.

Replace CO alarms:

In accordance with the manufacturer's instructions. Know what the "end-of-life" warning sounds like - consult the CO alarm manufacturer's instructions.
