Watering Restrictions

Even numbered houses may only water on even numbered days and odd numbered houses may only water on odd numbered watering days. The watering hours are between 6:00 am and 8:00 am. and between 6:00 pm and 9:00 pm. It is illegal to connect your sump pump to the sewer system. (By-Law 19-10)

A Word from the Fire Chief

As of April 15, 2015 it is mandatory for all residences with solid fuel burning appliances OR an attached garage to have working CO alarms as well as working smoke alarms on every level of their dwellings. If you do not have one of these devices present or in working order they will be issuing a \$235 fine for each faulty /or missing device.



If caught illegally dumping garbage, you could face **serious consequences** including a fine of \$1,000.00.

Information You Should Know . . .

No owner or person in charge of any animal shall allow the animal to defecate anywhere on property unless the owner ensures that the excreta are removed and disposed of in a sanitary manner. By-law No. 14-05 failure to comply is subject to a penalty. A reminder to **NOT** let your dogs or cats on beaches or playgrounds and be sure to **NOT** let them roam freely. **Be sure your pet is on a leash at all times.**

Recycling Information

Please keep bags (grocery, plastic from water bottles, outer milk bags, flyer bags, and dry cleaning) **together in one bag**. Be sure they aren't left loose in your bin. Keep Blue and Yellow bins separate. Container bins / boxes must not be larger than 18" x 20" x 21". Shredded paper is accepted in a clear bag. Cardboard with wax will not be picked up. Cardboard must be broken down or cut up and not be any larger than 3 feet by 2 feet. Please do not keep plastics and cans in plastic bags, keep them loose in your bin/box.

Open Air Burning Open air fires **are not** allowed from April 1st to October 31st. Open air fires **are** allowed from November 1st to March 31st.

Landfill News

Tipping fees will be waived for two weeks from Tuesday May 10 until Friday May 20th. During this time, our residents are able to drop off their items free of charge. Please note that bulky items **will have** a cost of \$10.00 **per** couch/mattress/love seat and fabric chair etc.

Bring your item to the Baggs Road Landfill during regular working hours. Tuesday 9 am to 6 pm and Wednesday to Saturday 9 am to 4 pm. Gently used items that may be useful to the next person may be dropped off at any time. There is no charge for anything you leave or take.

Methods for Paying for Taxes and Water/Sewer

Pre-Authorized, Cash, Cheque, On-line Banking (at participating banks), or at the Scotiabank Branch and Credit Union in Deep River. **Cheques** for taxes and water payments may be left in the night deposit box in Chalk River at 19 Railway or in Point Alexander 34465 Highway 17 at the main office.
