The Town currently has the following winter/summer equipment available to lend out to our residents: - Nordic walking poles, Pickle Ball, Snowshoes, Kayaks, Stand up paddle boards -Golf Clubs, assortment of sizes (children to adult) and life jackets. To sign for the equipment you must be 18 years of age and provide proof of ID. The equipment and lending forms are located at the Municipal office 34465 Highway 17 Monday to Friday from 8:30 am - 4:00 pm.

Seniors/Disabled Driveway Plowing

Point Alexander Skating Rink

Keep watch for new skating hours at the point Alexander rink. Hours will be posted on the side door.



- 2 bag limit per week for garbage - Bag tag required on the third or more bags - Maximum volume of 154 litres of household waste (without a tag) - All bags brought to Baggs Road Landfill will require payment of \$2.00 per bag. Wrap bag tag around neck of bag and stick ends together. - Tags can be purchased at the Town office or at Baggs Road -Copying or reproducing bag tags is illegal. For collection concerns contact the Town office :613-584-3114.

Fibre Recycling Yellow Box

-Newspaper, magazines, catalogues, flyers, junk mail -boxboard paperboard: cereal and cracker boxes, (no wax bag inside) egg cartons (no egg shells) toilet paper/paper towel rolls - Office paper (typing/computer paper -Cardboard (corrugated) must be broken down 2' x 2' brown "craft" paper bags, paper pet food bags (coated liner is ok) -soft cover books, hard cover books (spine and cover removed) -shredded paper in clear bags.

Commingled Blue Box

Tin cans (place lid inside and pinch can closed, empty paint cans, no plastic with metal tops and or bottoms or handles) -Aluminum cans, pie plates, trays, foil wrap (no foil with paper or plastic laminate) -clear + coloured glass food and beverage bottles (cleaned) -Plastic food and beverage containers #1 PET bottles, #2-#7 bottles, tubs and lids -Milk and juice cartons, ice cream (clean) -Grocery bags, (outer wrap from water, toilet paper, paper towels (place all these in one bag, bag of bags)

Summer Hours: March 13 to November 6, 2017 Tuesday 9 a.m.–6 p.m. and Wednesday to Saturday 9 a.m.–4 p.m.

Winter Hours: November 7, 2017 to March 10, 2018–Tuesday to Saturday 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Fees can be paid by cash at the Baggs Road site or at the Town office.

<u>Miller Road Landfill</u> <u>Construction and</u> <u>Demolition Waste Permits</u>

Permits can be purchased by cash from the Miller Road landfill or at the Deep River Municipal office.

<u>Planning on Building? When is a</u> <u>Permit Required</u>

Any new building over 108 ft 2 (9 x 12) including garages, decks, and porches. If a building is less than 108 ft 2 (9 x 12) it must still meet the zoning and all setback requirements for the property. Any addition to an existing building including porches or decks. Any extensive renovations that would include structural alterations. Demolition of any building. All sewage systems. Partitioning and finishing a basement. Damp proofing or waterproofing foundation walls, including installation of drainage tile.



Water Samples Drop off

Water Sample Bottles are available at the municipal office in Point Alexander. Samples to be taken the <u>same day</u> as they are dropped off. September to March -> Drop off Tuesday and Wednesday <u>only</u>. April to August->Drop off Monday to Thursdays.

Recycling Calendars


Your <u>NEW</u> 2018/2019 recycling calendar will be available by February/March. If you do not receive one by mid March you may pick one up at the municipal office.
