3. DELEGATIONS AND PRESENTATIONS - None

4. **<u>NEW BUSINESS</u>**

(a) The Committee reviewed and discussed an MNRF Work Permit Application for erosion control along the Ottawa River on Part Lot 21, Range B in the geographic Township of Rolph.

The Committee recommended that MNRF be informed that there were no objections to the Work Permit as presented.

(b) The Committee reviewed and discussed an MNRF Work Permit Application for erosion control along the Ottawa River on Part Lot 38, Range B in the geographic Township of Rolph.

The Committee recommended that MNRF be informed that there were no objections to the Work Permit as presented.

(c) The Committee reviewed and discussed Application for Consent No. B72/17 to create a residential lot on Part Lot 8, Concession 1, Township of Rolph owned by William Charles.

The Committee recommended the Application for Consent be approved with the condition that an application for a Zoning By-Law Amendment be submitted to reduce the required frontage on a municipally maintained road.

(d) The Committee reviewed and discussed an application for a Zoning By-Law Amendment for Part Lot 8, Concession 1, Township of Rolph owned by William Charles.

The Committee deemed the application complete and recommended the Planning Coordinator proceed with the zoning amendment process.

(e) The Committee reviewed a request for purchase of part of the unopened road allowance behind 69 Lance Road. This unopened road allowance was offered to all the previous property owners on Lance road. The property former owner did not purchase the road allowance behind his property the new owner would to acquire the property.

The Committee recommended the sale of the portion of the unopened road allowance directly behind 69 Lance Road be approved.

(f) The Committee reviewed a request for transfer of part of Stewart Lane the unopened road allowance.

The Committee deferred any decision on this matter until the Public Works Superintendent could review and submit comments on the unopened road allowance.

(g) The Committee reviewed and discussed a request from WCCT to erect a wireless internet tower in Chalk River.

The Committee expressed interest in bringing wireless internet to Chalk River and suggested WCCT find a suitable location for a tower.
