#### YELLOW BOX

Boxboard (cereal, tissue, etc), cardboard catalogues & magazines, file folders greetings cards, junk mail, newspapers and flyers (includes glossy), phone books, soft cover books, hard cover books (covers and bindings removed) wrapping (non metallic only) and tissue paper, coloured and white paper and envelopes, paper towel/toilet paper rolls, shredding in clear plastic bags, frozen food boxes

**BLUE BOX** Empty, dry metal paint cans (lids removed), empty aerosol cans, non-refundable glass bottles & jars (lids removed), cartons (milk, juice, cream) drinking boxes, plastic bags: bread, outer milk bag, frozen food, dry cleaning & grocery, aluminum plates & cans, plastic containers with symbols 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 (food and beverage containers, household cleaning products, laundry detergent & shampoo bottles) white styrofoam products (plates, cups, meat trays, egg cartons, packaging), steel cans, cardboard cans (frozen juice, peanuts, hot chocolate) small scrap metal items (utensils, pots & pans, baking sheets, metal coat hangers, small appliances, tools, with cords and batteries removed-must fit in blue bin) steel cans, yoghurt/pudding/applesauce cups

**NOT ACCEPTED IN EITHER RECYCLING BINS**: Bubble wrap, blister plastic packaging, binders, toys, candy bar wrappers, CD DVD's and cases, VHS tapes and cases, cookie bags, Styrofoam packing peanuts and colored Styrofoam, ceramics, cereal/cracker box liner, chip bags, shoes, plastic strapping, Christmas tree lights, clothesline, cork, dialysis tubing, dishes, dog/cat food bags, light bulbs, (incandescent) milk bag (inner) remote controls, photographs, planting trays/pots, plastic cutlery, plastic wrap, pool noodles, rope, garden hoses, sandwich bags, straws, plastic paint cans. These items <u>*WILL*</u> contaminate your yellow/blue bins. Please dispose of them in your regular garbage. Please ensure all liquor & wine/beer bottles (glass and/or plastic) are returned to the Beer Store for a refund.

### BAGGS ROAD LANDFILL

Winter Hours of Operation: Tuesday to Saturday 9:00 am - 4:00 pm Summer Hours of Operation: Tuesday 9:00 am - 6:00 pm Wednesday to Saturday 9:00 am - 4:00 pm

Regular garbage, which includes window glass, mirrors, ceramic, dishes, diapers, kitty litter, cooking oil/grease, table scraps, toothpaste tubes, furnace filters, chip bags, etc. Appliances, mattresses and upholstered furniture, non commercial car and light truck tires with or without rims up to 20 inches are also accepted. Metal waste such as plumbing pipes, metal ceilings, siding, or roofing, reinforcing rods, metal studs, I-beams, stoves, refrigerators and other such appliances (and WEE products); angle iron and heating ductwork and other metal materials are also accepted at Baggs Rd. Brush is also accepted.

#### HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE PCB-containing materials will not be accepted.

Hazardous waste includes: automobile, truck, motorcycle or tractor lead/acid batteries, paint in cans, propane tanks (empty) used motor oil, appliances containing refrigerant (freezers, refrigeration and dehumidifiers) engine antifreeze (ie glycol) fertilizers, pesticides, gasoline, diesel fuel, kerosene, varisol, methanol or other

## MILLER ROAD LANDFILL CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION WASTE

Hours of Operation Tuesday to Saturday 9:00 am to 12 pm Construction and demolition waste is defined as all non-hazardous low metal content waste from construction and demolition clean up projects, consisting primarily of; wood, blocks/stone/bricks, non-metal roofing material, insulation, waste furniture (does not include mattresses and box springs), window glass, sinks, toilets, non metal siding material, concrete and small amounts of plastic and fiberglass.
