A Word from the Fire Chief

As of April 15, 2015 it is mandatory for all residences with solid fuel burning appliances OR an attached garage to have working CO alarms as well as working smoke alarms on every level of their dwellings. After June 15, 2015, any time the Fire Department finds that you do not have one of these devices present or in working order they will be issuing a \$235 fine for each faulty /or missing device. WATER SAMPLE DROP OFF

Water Sample Bottles are available at the municipal office in Point Alexander. Samples to be taken the *same day* as they are dropped off.

September to March -> Drop off Tuesday and Wednesday <u>only</u> and from April to August-> Monday to Thursday. No owner or person in charge of any animal shall allow the animal to defecate anywhere on property unless the owner ensures that the excreta are removed and disposed of in a sanitary manner. By-law No. 14-05 failure to comply is subject to a penalty. A reminder to **NOT** let your dogs or cats on beaches or playgrounds and be sure to **NOT** let them roam freely. <u>Be sure your pet is on a</u> <u>leash at all times.</u>

Cardboard with wax will not be picked up. Cardboard must be broken down or cut up and not be larger than 3' X 2'. If your recycling has not been picked up, please check your bin for a sticker. The sticker will have a brief description as to why it wasn't picked up.


Meetings (Council + Committee)

If You See A Bear **Emergency Situations**



CALL 911 if a black bear poses an immediate threat to personal safety by exhibiting threatening or aggressive behavior, such as:

Entering a school yard when school is in session -Stalking people and lingering at the site

-Entering or trying to enter a -Wandering into a residence public gathering -Killing livestock/pets and is lingering at the site.

Non-Emergency Encounters

Call the toll-free Bear Wise reporting line at 1-866-514-2327 (TTY 705-945-7641) if a black bear is: Roaming around, checking garbage cans -Breaking into a shed where garbage or food is stored -In a tree -Pulling down a bird feeder or knocking over a barbecue -Moving through a backyard or field but is not lingering.
