NEW Recycling Information

Watch for the **NEW** 12 Month Calendar in your mail. If you haven't received one, please visit the office at 34465 Highway 17.

Take note of the Holiday pick-up changes for Garbage and Recycling during Christmas, Boxing Day, New Years, Easter and Canada Day.

Recycling pick-up will alternate between containers one week (plastic/glass/tin) and fibres the next week (cardboard/paper)

Residents who have their garbage picked up on Tuesday will have their recycling picked up on Wednesdays.

Residents who have their garbage picked up on Friday will have their recycling picked up on Thursdays.

YELLOW BOX - Fibre Household newspaper, magazines, catalogues, flyers and junk mail • Boxboard/paperboard: cereal boxes (no wax bags inside), cracker boxes, tissue boxes, "paper" egg cartons (no eggshells), toilet paper/paper towel rolls • Office paper, eg. writing, typing and computer paper
Cardboard, corrugated brown paper bags • Soft cover books, hard cover books with spine and cover removed only • Coffee/pop trays • Shredded paper must be in a clear plastic bag • Cardboard to be broken into 2' x 2' bundles and tied.

Yellow Bin pick-up will no longer include pizza boxes or fast food paper cups.

BLUE BOX - Tin cans (place lid inside and pinch can so lid stays in) • Open and empty metal paint cans (no plastic paint cans with metal tops and/or bottoms) Aluminum cans, pie plates, trays • Clear and coloured glass food and beverage bottles and jars scraped and empty and rinsed clean Plastic food and beverage containers, #1 water bottles, #2 - #7 bottles, tubs and lids • Milk and juice cartons, drinking boxes • Clean ice cream containers

Blue Bin pick-up will no longer include black plastic trays (mushroom/meat trays) plastic bags or fast food plastic drink cup or lids.

Garbage Collection Guidelines

2 bag limit per week for garbage - Bag tag required on the third or more bags - Maximum volume of 154 litres of household waste (without a tag) - All bags brought to Baggs Road Landfill will require payment of \$2.00 per bag. Wrap bag tag around neck of bag and stick ends together. - Tags can be purchased at the Town office or at Baggs Road-Copying or reproducing bag tags is illegal. For collection concerns contact the Town office 613-584-3114.

Lending Hub

The Town currently has the following equipment available to lend out to our residents: - Nordic walking poles, Pickle Ball equipment, golf clubs, assortment of sizes (children to adult). To sign for the equipment you must be 18 years of age and provide proof of ID. The equipment and lending forms are located at the Municipal office 34465 Highway 17 from Monday to Friday from 8:30 am - 4:00 pm.

A Word from the Fire Chief and Firefighters

It is mandatory for all residences with solid fuel burning appliances OR an attached garage to have working CO alarms as well as working smoke alarms on every level of their dwellings. If you do not have one of these devices present or in working order, and if the fire department responds to a call at your home, you may be subject to a \$235 fine for each faulty /or missing device. Water Samples Drop off
