Recycling—BLUE Bin



Grocery bags, outer wrap from toilet paper / cases of water and paper towels (all in one bag and clean), Milk and juice cartons, Ice cream containers (rinsed and clean), Tin cans (place lid inside and pinch can so lid stays in, open and empty paint cans (no plastic with metal tops and/or bottoms or handles), Aluminum cans, pie plates, trays and foil wrap (no foil with paper or plastic laminate), Clear and coloured glass.

Recycling—YELLOW Bin



Newspaper, magazines, flyers, box-board/paperboard (cereal boxes—no wax bags) clean pizza boxes, egg cartons, toilet paper/paper towel rolls, office paper, cardboard (must be broken down into 2' x 2' bundled and tied), soft cover books and shredded paper.

GARBAGE



Small scrap metal, Dog/cat food bags, dirty pizza boxes, all colours of styrofoam, frozen juice cans, hard covered books, Tupperware, Rubbermaid, toys, bread bags, window pane glass, wood and wax boxes.

Aerosol Cans are *Household Hazardous Waste*.

Volunteer Driver's Needed

In 2015 Volunteer drivers transported 151 clients from North Renfrew a total of 88421 kilometres to medical and other appointments in town and long distance to Pembroke, Ottawa and points in between. Volunteers drive clients in their own vehicle or in one of the Centre's wheelchair accessible vans. North Renfrew Long-Term Care Services currently requires more volunteer drivers. Drivers must have a clear Driver's Abstract and a clear Criminal Record and Vulnerable Sector Check. Volunteers using their own vehicles are reimbursed per kilometre for long distance drives.

Baggs Road Landfill

Winter Hours: are November 8, 2016 to March 14, 2017. Tuesday to Saturday 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Summer Hours: March 15 to November 5, 2016, Tuesday 9 a.m. - 6 p.m. and Wednesday to Saturday 9 a.m. - 4 p.m. Fees can be paid at the Baggs Road site or the Town office.

No owner or person in charge of any animal shall allow the animal to defecate anywhere on property unless the owner ensures that the excreta are removed and disposed of in a sanitary manner. By-law No. 14-05 failure to comply is subject to a penalty. A reminder to **NOT** let your dogs or cats on beaches or playgrounds and be sure to **NOT** let them roam freely.

WATER SAMPLE DROP OFF

Water Sample Bottles are available at the municipal office in Point Alexander. Samples to be taken the same day as they are dropped off.

September to March → Drop off Tuesday and Wednesday only and from April to August → Monday to Thursday only.

If You See A Bear

Emergency Situations

CALL 911 if a black bear poses an immediate threat to personal safety by exhibiting threatening or aggressive behavior, such as:

- Entering a school yard when school is in session
- Stalking people and lingering at the site
- Entering or trying to enter a residence
- Wandering into a public gathering
- Killing live-stock/pets and is lingering at the site.

Non-Emergency Encounters

Call the toll-free Bear Wise reporting line at 1-866-514-2327 (TTY 705-945-7641) if a black bear is: Roaming around, checking garbage cans -Breaking into a shed where garbage or food is stored -In a tree -Pulling down a bird feeder or knocking over a barbecue -Moving through a backyard or field but is not lingering.
