2. DECLARATION OF PECUNIARY INTEREST

3. CHALK RIVER – WATER CONCERNS

The Mayor welcomed everyone present. He stated that the meeting tonight was a follow up to the October 18<sup>th</sup> Council meeting and was for information purposes only. There would be no debate with Council or with staff and that the Public Works Superintendent had been invited to attend the meeting to provide Council with some information.

The Public Works Superintendent informed Council that the Town has an inventory of 25,000 feet of culverts (7.62 kilometres). He gave Council an overview of the ditching, flushing and drywell cleaning that had been done to date in Chalk River. The planned ditching for the Park side of Railway Street will most likely be deferred to next year. He also informed Council that they were fabricating a ditch bucket that will make the cleaning out of the wetter ditches easier and quicker. Public works will continue to do ditching in Chalk River along Railway and Main Streets weather permitting.

A fact sheet from the Ontario Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Affairs on drainage was made available to all those in attendance to take with them.
