Working under the supervision of the Chief Building Official the Building Inspector is responsible to review all construction drawings, issuing of permits and perform on-site inspections of all construction (buildings, structures, alterations, additions, renovations, and septic disposal systems) development and demolition in accordance with the Ontario Building Code Act, Municipal By-laws and all applicable legislation.

The ideal applicant should have a diploma or degree in a discipline related directly to building design and construction. A minimum of two (2) years-experience working extensively with the Ontario Building Code in building design **OR** the equivalent combination of education and experience. Successful completion **OR** working towards the completion of the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing examination program relating to "General Legal", "Small Buildings". Qualification in the On-Site sewage systems would be considered an asset.
