

RCD COVID-19 Vaccine Rollout at a Glance

Update: March 30, 2021



Key Messages

1. Eligible people who can currently register for a vaccination appointment can visit www.rcdhu.com or ontario.ca/bookvaccine. If you can't access the online system, ask a family member or friend to assist you.

2. If you can't register online, please call RCDHU at 613-735-9724 or 1-800-267-1097 extension 200. The phone lines will be answered 7 days/week, from 8:00 am - 4:00 pm. **Please leave your name and number, and only leave one voice message.**

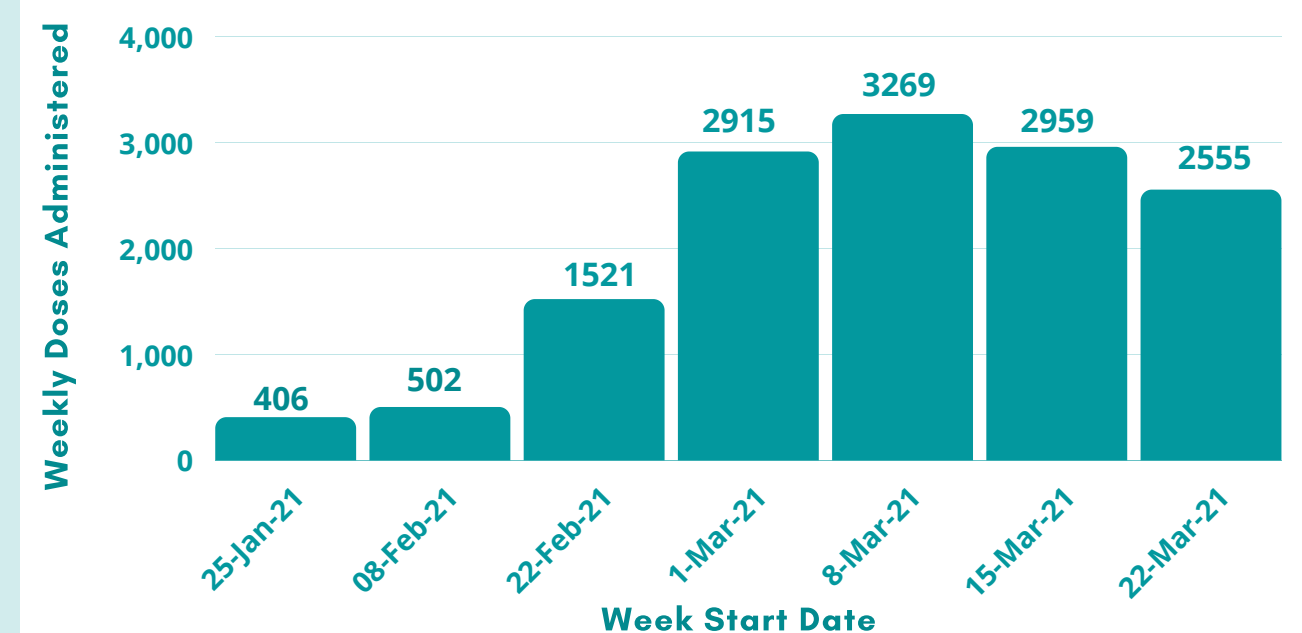
3. Following the National Advisory Committee on Immunization's recommendation to delay the second dose, **all second doses, except for a minority of classifications, will be administered 16 weeks after the first.** Eligible people will receive notification on when they can register for their second vaccination appointment.

Local Snapshot

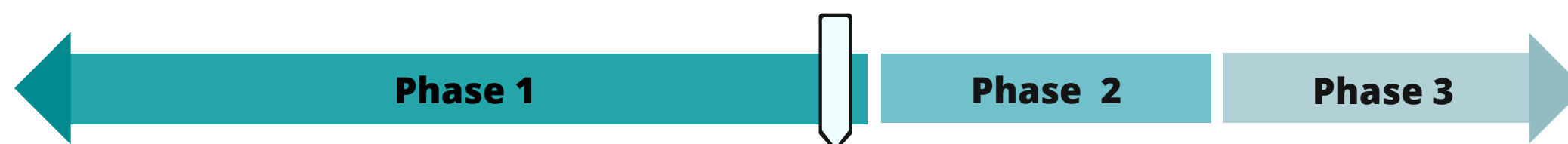
Total Doses Administered to Date **14,127**

Eligible people who can pre-register & book appointments



Phase 1:

- > People 75 years of age and older (born in 1946 or earlier)
- > Indigenous adults 18+
- > All healthcare workers
- > Anyone receiving chronic home care that have been identified by home health care organizations*
- > All seniors in congregate care residences
- > Long-term care and retirement home essential caregivers
- > Faith based leaders who, as part of their role, provide end of life care, care of the deceased, home visits to unwell persons, or pastoral care in LTC/RHs or other vulnerable settings

* This group will receive a call notifying them that they are eligible to register.

Eligible people who can pre-register but are currently unable to book an appointment

- > People 70-74 years of age (born between 1947-1951)
- i **Note:** Vaccine appointment availability will be based on the number of doses that RCD receives each week. People should anticipate that it will take a number of weeks to complete the eligible groups.
