Emergency Preparedness Information

TAKE NOTE RE: Community Garbage Drop Areas

Leaving garbage that has been torn out of your garbage bag from animals/birds is disrespectful to your neighbours/community. Please pick up your garbage and keep Laurentian Hills clean.

Residents that bring household waste to a central or common collection point, are reminded that the Contractors are not responsible to pick up any waste that has been strewn about by animals or from the trash bags breaking open. It is recommended that garbage cans/containers be used to avoid garbage ending up on a neighbours' property or attracting unwanted animals.



Water Samples Drop off

Water Sample Bottles are available at the municipal office in Point Alexander. Samples are to be taken the **same day** as they are dropped off and preferably after noon. May to August—Drop off days are **Mondays** and **Wednesdays ONLY**. September to April—Drop off **Tuesday ONLY**.

Information Regarding Pets

Be sure your pet is on a leash **at all times** and do **not** let them roam freely. **Not all people are comfortable with meeting up with an unleashed dog.** Please be respectful and keep your dog on a leash at all times **and always pick up after your pet.**

[Taxes and Water and Sewer Payments](#)

The following options are available: Monthly Pre-Authorized, Cash, Cheque, On-line Banking (at **participating banks below**), or at Scotiabank, Bank of Montreal and Credit Union in Deep River. Cheques for taxes and water payments may be left in the night deposit box in Chalk River at 19 Railway Street or in Point Alexander 34465 Highway 17 at the main office. [Planning on Building? Permit Required?](#)

Any new building over 100 ft² (10 x 10) including garages, decks, and porches requires a permit. If a building is less than 100 ft² (10 x 10) it must still meet the zoning and all setback requirements for the property. This includes any addition to an existing building including porches or deck as well as any extensive renovations that would include structural alterations or demolition of any building, all sewage systems, partitioning and finishing a basement, damp proofing or waterproofing foundation walls, including installation of drainage tile.
