**New Items that are Now Recyclable** Please Take Note: Residents should be placing their soft flexible plastics (bubble wrap, chip bags, candy wrappers, plastic bags, bread bags, cereal liner bags) in with their paper/fiber recycling. In with your containers and plastics, please recycle paper cups, ice cream containers, plastic plant pots, empty medication bottles, deodorant and toothpaste tubes, hand cream tubes as well as all foam / Styrofoam packaging. This includes all Styrofoam (including black), foam and plastic meat trays (remove the absorbent pads from trays) foam plates, bowls, cups, take out containers.

**Changes to Ontario Fire Code: New Requirements for CO Alarms** A slew of changes to the Ontario Fire Code will take effect on January 1, 2026. The changes will improve harmonization of the *Ontario Fire Code* with the *2020 National Fire Code of Canada* and introduce new requirements to enhance fire-prevention safety. This includes changes to where carbon monoxide (CO) alarms must be placed in existing homes, including detached or semi-detached houses, townhouses and cottages. The updated requirements apply to all existing homes that have any of the following: •A fuel-burning appliance (like a furnace, water heater, or stove that uses natural gas, propane, oil, or wood) •A fireplace •An attached garage •Air for heating that comes from a fuel-burning appliance not contained within the home (e.g., an appliance in a utility shed). If your home meets any of the conditions above, a CO alarm must be installed: 1. Adjacent to each sleeping area (near all bedrooms) 2. On every storey (floor) of your home, including storeys that do not have a sleeping area. These requirements are outlined in Section 2.16 of Division B of the Fire Code (O. ## Taxes and Water and Sewer Payments

The following options are available: Monthly Pre-Authorized, Cash, Cheque, On-line Banking (at participating banks below), or at Scotiabank, Bank of Montreal and Credit Union in Deep River. Cheques for taxes and water payments may be left in the night deposit box in Chalk River at 19 Railway Street or in Point Alexander 34465 Highway 17 at the main office. The Municipality will not be responsible for cash left in the drop box. For more information, please call the office at 613-584-3114.

**Planning on Building? Permit Required?** Constructing a new building larger than 10 m<sup>2</sup> (approximately 108 ft<sup>2</sup>) (exceptions apply for small garden sheds up to 15 m<sup>2</sup>) This includes any addition to an existing building including porches, pole sheds or decks as well as any extensive renovations that would include structural alterations or demolition of any building, all sewage systems, partitioning and finishing a basement, damp proofing or waterproofing foundation walls, including installation of drainage tile. If a building is less than 108ft<sup>2</sup> (10 m<sup>2</sup>) it must still meet the zoning and all setback requirements for the property. If you are unsure whether your project needs a permit, it's always best to contact the Town's Building & Planning Department before beginning work.

**Garbage Collection Guidelines** 2 bag limit per week for garbage - Bag tag required on the third or more bags - Maximum volume of 154 litres of household waste (without a tag) - All bags brought to the Baggs Road Landfill will require payment of \$2.00 per bag. Wrap bag tag around neck of bag and stick ends together. Tags can be purchased at the Town office or at Baggs Road. Copying or reproducing bag tags is illegal.
