2. <u>DECLARATION OF PECUNIARY INTEREST</u> - There were no declarations of pecuniary interest.

#### 3. **DELEGATIONS**

(a) Mr. Bob McLaren, Royal Canadian Legion, Chalk River Re: Restrictions for ATV's and Snowmobiles.

Mr. McLaren on behalf of the Chalk River Legion appeared as a delegation to request that consideration be given to allowing ATV's and snowmobiles to travel on Wilson Street and Legion Street to beyond the Legion access. This would mean removing the No ATV sign on Wilson and moving the No ATV sign on Legion Street back further to just beyond the Legion access to their property. The Legion would like to attract snowmobilers and ATV riders using the Algonquin Trail into the Legion to increase business.

(b) Mr. Marc Lachance regarding FOI Document Release / Concrete Plant in Chalk River.

Mr. Marc Lachance appeared as a delegation regarding the cement plant in Chalk River to requesting that Council give consideration to implementing the following:

- Hold a Special Meeting and invite the concrete plan proponents to attend to allow residents to ask questions and make comments and/or express concerns and address/identify issues that needs to be addressed.
- 2. Appoint a Special Committee consisting of Council members from Ward 3 and 4 and 2-3 concerned citizens along with representatives from Chandos Bird and Sullivan Joint Venture to ensure that all environmental regulations relating to the facility are adhered to and include a complaint process for residents.
- 3. Enact a noise by-law that permits the operation of construction equipment Monday to Friday 7:00am to 7:00pm. Saturdays 9:00am to 7:00p.m. and no construction noise on Sundays and statutory holidays.
