Airborne Petawawa Launches 2026 Skydiving Season with New Accessibility, Training, and Military Support Initiatives

Petawawa, ON – Airborne Petawawa officially opens its 2026 skydiving season on May 2, 2026, introducing new programs focused on accessibility, and advanced skydiver training in the Ottawa Valley.

Operating out of the Pembroke & Area Airport, Airborne Petawawa continues to grow as a premier adventure tourism destination, offering tandem skydives and a solo licence program from 12,500 feet with views of the Ottawa River and Algonquin Park.

What's New for 2026

CANEX No-Interest Credit Plan

Canadian Armed Forces members and their families can now finance a full skydiving licence through the CANEX plan.

Accessible Tandem Skydiving – FREEDOM Harness

A major step forward in inclusion, this program allows individuals with limited mobility, including wheelchair users, to experience skydiving safely.

GoPro 360° Experience Video Package

A fully immersive, virtual reality-ready video package that captures every angle of the skydive.

USPA Coach Course (Sept 5–7, 2026)

Airborne Petawawa will host a United States Parachute Association Coach Course, giving Canadian skydivers rare local access to an internationally recognized instructional rating, helping elevate safety and skill across the sport.
