TOWN OF LAURENTIAN HILLS 2022 ELECTION

The last day for a candidate to file a nomination for the 2022 Municipal election for Council and School Board trustees was Friday August 19th at 2:00 p.m. All candidates running for municipal Council were certified and acclaimed to their positions as follows.

For the position of Mayor: Anne Giardini, Ward 1 Councillor: Bruce Boucher, Ward 2 Councillor: Gary McAnulty, Ward 3 Councillor: Brenda Blimkie and Ward 4 Councillor: John Hoyle.

The 2022 election will be held only for the voting of School Board Trustees. One (1) candidate to be elected for the Renfrew County Catholic School Board and one candidate to be elected for Conseil des écoles catholiques du Centre-Est.

If you are eligible to vote for the School Boards (English Separate and French Separate) an Advanced poll will be held Saturday October 15th from 11:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. for Wards 1 and 2 at the Point Alexander Municipal Office located at 34465 Highway 17 and for Wards 3 and 4 at the Chalk River Fire Hall located on Kellett Street in the Village of Chalk River.

Regular poll will be held on October 24th, 2022 from 10:00 am to 8:00 p.m. for Wards 1 and 2 in the Point Alexander Municipal Office 34465 Highway 17 and for Wards 3 and 4 at the Chalk River Lions Hall on Kellett Street in the Village of Chalk River.

Community Garbage Drop Area

Residents that bring **household waste** / **recycling** to a central or common collection point, are reminded that the Contractor is not responsible to pick up any waste that has been strewn about by animals or from the trash bags breaking open. This also includes construction and demolition waste (Must be brought to the Millers Road Landfill.) It is recommended that garbage cans be used to avoid garbage attracting unwanted animals.

Be Bear Wise

If a bear is roaming around, checking garbage cans, breaking into a shed where garbage or food is stored, in a tree, pulling down a bird feeder, knocking over a bbq, moving through a backyard or field but is not lingering call the **non-emergencies** Bear Wise reporting line at [1-866-514-2327](tel:1-866-514-2327) (*between April 1–November 30)

If you feel a bear poses an immediate threat to personal safety or enters a school yard when school is in session, enters or tries to enter a residence, wanders into a public gathering, kills livestock/pets and lingers at the site, stalks people and lingers at the site **call 911 for emergencies.**

Taxes and Water and Sewer Payments

The following options are available: Monthly Pre-Authorized, Cash, Cheque, On-line Banking (at participating banks below), or at Scotiabank, Bank of Montreal and Credit Union in Deep River. Cheques for taxes and water payments may be left in the night deposit box in Chalk River at 19 Railway St. or in Point Alexander 34465 Highway 17 at the main office. Planning on Building? Permit Required?

Any new building over 108 ft² (9 x 12) including garages, decks, and porches. If a building is less than 108 ft² (9 x 12) it must still meet the zoning and all setback requirements for the property. Any addition to an existing building including porches or decks. Any extensive renovations that would include structural alterations. Demolition of any building. All sewage systems. Partitioning and finishing a basement. Damp proofing or waterproofing foundation walls, including installation of drainage tile.

Request for Participation

Chalk River Water System Users

In order to comply with provincial regulations and as part of the ongoing efforts to ensure the safety of drinking water, the municipality must test the drinking water supply for the presence of lead. The Town of Laurentian Hills is looking for Businesses and Residential Home Owners who are connected to the Chalk River Water System to participate in the testing and permit staff from the Water Treatment Plant to take water samples for lead testing. The testing will be performed twice a year and each test will take approximately 45 minutes. Testing periods are once between June 15, 2022 to October 15, 2022 and once between March 1, 2023 to April 15, 2023. Volunteers will be given ample notice prior to any testing and will be provided of copies of the test results. If you are willing to participate and allow the Town to sample water please contact the Town office at 613-584-3114.
