Most types of HHW are acceptable including:

Motor oil	Diesel fuel	Acids
Hydraulic/transmission fluids	Solvents	Alkaline wastes
Organic/inorganic chemicals	Paint	Soap/detergent
Automotive batteries	Heating oil	Fluorescent lights
Gasoline	Antifreeze	Fertilizers, pesticides
Rechargeable/dry cell batteries	Compressed gas cylinders (eg: propane, butane)	
Refrigerant-containing appliances (eg: refrigerators, dehumidifiers)		

Note: Dry empty paint cans can be recycled (blue box).

All types of WEEE are acceptable including:

All Computers including keyboard, mouse, drives, printers, scanners, monitors (CRT, LCD, Plasma)		
Fax Machines	Copiers	CD & DVD players/recorders
Telephones & Cell Phones	Cameras	Televisions (all types)
Pagers, PDAs, Phones	Radios, Receivers, Stereos, Speakers & Turntables	Audio & Video players/projectors

WEEE material is sent for proper reuse, refurbishment or recycling.

All TIRES, on or off rims, are accepted free of charge and are recycled.
Hazardous wastes, if handled improperly, can cause damage to people & the environment.
